INTERNATIONAL CERAMICS FESTIVAL 2023

Since it began in 1987, this three-day festival has grown to become the UK's leading ceramics event. It offers teachers, students, ceramic artists, collectors, working potters, amateurs and lovers of craft, the chance to meet and study the work of distinguished, internationally known potters and ceramicists from Wales, the UK and around the world.

The Festival attracts over 1,000 people who attend lectures, watch practical demonstrations and visit our special exhibitions. Our international demonstrators show skills and techniques on our specially adapted stage and also have their own workspaces – enabling personal discussion about their work. The focus is both practical and inspirational – kilns are built, pots are made and fired.

The Festival supports emerging makers and has opportunities for students and recent graduates who work with clay through ceramics, fine art or 3-D design courses.

The Festival offer visitors opportunities to take part during the festival with a variety of hands on activities, as well as being able to vote for the Lifetime Achievement award and donate their work to the Cup Sale.

The festival's materials are sponsored by Potclays, one of the UK's main ceramics suppliers, and is supported by other ceramic supply companies such as Cromartie and Top Pot Supplies. It has financial support from the Welsh Arts Council and the Welsh Government.

The organisers are Wales's two potters groups, North Wales Potters and South Wales Potters together with Aberystwyth University.

Award winning Aberystwyth Arts Centre is Wales' largest arts centre and recognised as a "national flagship for the arts." Aberystwyth Arts Centre is a department of Aberystwyth University and a member of the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences.

TRANSPORT INFORMATION By Car

The Arts Centre is situated at the heart of the Aberystwyth University campus, post code SY23 3DE. The turning onto campus is from the A487 and is well signposted. There are large car parks adjacent to the Arts Centre and on campus which are free for customers in the evening after 17.00 and at weekends. Please note that if you are visiting the Arts Centre during the daytime you should follow the signs to the Visitors Car Park, for which there is a small charge.

Public transport

Train services to Aberystwyth from Birmingham, Shrewsbury, Newtown and Machynlleth run every one to two hours except on Sundays. Please see www.nationalrail.co.uk for more detailed information.

The train station in Aberystwyth is adjacent to the main bus and coach terminals. There are a number of buses and coaches that run from the centre of Aberystwyth to the Arts Centre. <u>Bus routes 301, 305 and 03</u> provide a convenient link from the town centre and seafront to the University's Penglais Campus and the Arts Centre, with other local buses serving the immediate suburbs. The walking time from Aberystwyth Arts Centre to the town centre is about 20 minutes, but please bear in mind that Penglais Hill is quite a steep climb so it takes longer coming back! There are bus stops at the campus entrance.

ATMs


The whole University campus and Arts Centre are cashless. The ICF will be dealing with both card and cash. Free ATM's can be found on site:
